1 “An Evening with....”

We have lined up speakers for a series of special events running from October until May 2014. You can spend an evening in conversation with, amongst others, politician Annabel Goldie, noted Glasgow solicitor Len Murray and football commentator Jock Brown. The events which will involve hospitality will be ticketed with dates to be announced.

2 Christmas Festival

On 11th December a special event will be held in our halls to celebrate Christmas involving refreshments and entertainment.

3 Vintage Evening

We will hold a social evening on 25th April 2014 as if it were 25th April 1914.

4 Baptism 100

An invitation will be extended to the family and friends of the last 100 children to be baptised in St Mary's Church to a picnic party on 7th June 2014.

5 Canal Cruises

St Marys has seen many boats pass by its doorstep along the Canal and during the summer we will be hosting our own cruises on the Canal.

6 Flower Festival

The Church will be decorated by our Flower Circle and open to the public on 6th September 2014.

7 Centenary Service 14th September 2014

This will represent the culmination of our year with a service on the anniversary of the dedication of the Church.
