In this Season of Advent, as our thoughts turn towards Christmas when we celebrate the birth of our Saviour, Jesus Christ, outside it seems there is much darkness in our world. But we have an Advent hope in the one who can take that darkness and transform it through the light of His presence. He is the reason for the season of our celebrations.

As a congregation we have been travelling through our vacancy with a natural sense of anxiety, as our path has seemed quite dark and unclear. However the Kirk Session has recently agreed to repay £56,500 from our reserves towards our Ministries and Mission deficit. This will leave a remaining balance of £60,000 and it is proposed that we repay this over the next 5 years. Our proposal has been agreed in principle with representatives of the Presbytery of Glasgow, and 121 George Street, Edinburgh, allowing us to have the right to call a new Minister on a reviewable basis in the New Year.
